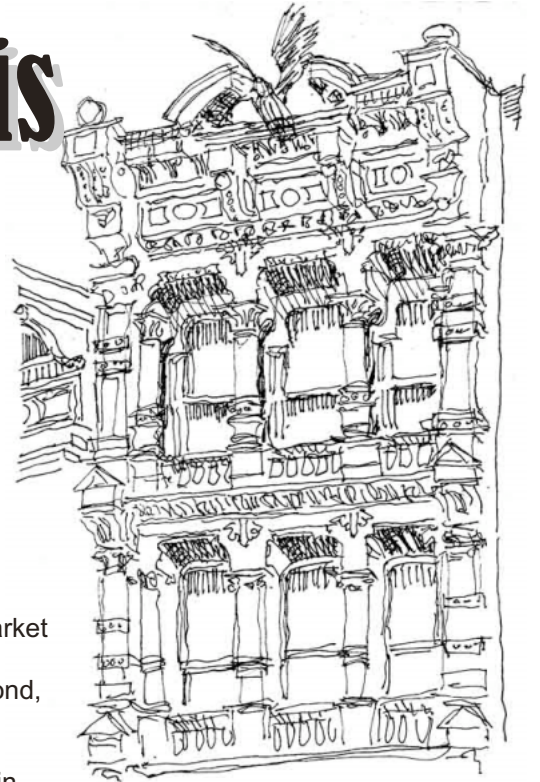


Independent Workshop 2009 Registration

Class Description: A course in the art of drawing and painting in sketch books with pen and ink and watercolor washes open to artists of all levels interested in working outdoors with a group. Each location has been selected for class focus on specific landscape, figure and architectural drawing challenges that face the artist when working outdoors. The objective of the course is to train the artist how to draw these subjects with speed and accuracy. Classes will include instruction in basic drawing principles of line, form, texture, composition and perspective. Informational handouts will be provided at each class.

Supplies: Sketchbook, ink pen and watercolor set are included in class fee. Participants should bring a small bag or back pack to carry drawing materials as well as pencil, sharpener, kneaded eraser, tissues or paper towels, plastic bag, water bottle, brush washer, digital camera (optional), snacks, umbrella, bug spray, sun screen, etc. Whatever just keep it light and anticipate a lot of walking!
