**YOUNG ARTISTS' SHOWCASE**

Young Artists' Showcase is a walk-in, all media exhibition of local high school students' artwork juried by Marilynne Bradley, Professor of Art, Webster University. The exhibition will showcase artwork by students between the ages 15 to 19 living within 150 miles of the St. Louis Artists' Guild. The YAS encourages and supports the artistic talents and creativity of a wide segment of young, emerging artists in the St. Louis community; many of whom will experience their first opportunity to exhibit in a professional gallery space. The winning artist will receive a \$500 scholarship prize from Emerson, while others will receive cash and merchandise awards from the restricted Guild Prize Endowment Fund.

**ARTWORK MUST MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS**

- Artist must be 15–19 years of age and live within 150 miles of the St. Louis Artists' Guild.
- One entry per student and/or a maximum of 10 entries per school may be submitted.
- Juror will consider originality.
- Completed within the current school year.
- Not shown previously in the St. Louis Artists' Guild galleries.
- Works should be priced and marked for sale or not for sale (NFS).
- 2-D: Shall not exceed image size of 72" h x 84" w and 30 lbs. Diptychs and triptychs which exceed maximum size limitations for a single entry (72" x 84") will be considered as 2 or 3 entries depending on total size.
- Works on paper must be under glass or Plexiglas. Plexiglas must be used on all works over 18" x 24".
- Hanging work should have wire and screw eyes. No saw-tooth hangers. No clip frames.
- Wraparound canvases acceptable if edges are painted and all nails and staples do not show.
- 3-D: Must not exceed 85" h x 35" w x 50" d and 100 lbs.
- All entries must be suitably presented and ready for installation. All installation material and written instruction, if needed, must accompany work.

The St. Louis Artists' Guild has the right to reject any work that is unstable, unusually fragile or does not meet the above requirements.

Entries submitted for this exhibit must be hand-delivered to the St. Louis Artists' Guild during the dates and times specified.

**DATES:** Saturday or Sunday, March 7, 8

**TIME:** Noon–3 p.m.

Directions: The St. Louis Artists' Guild is located at Two Oak Knoll Park in Clayton. Oak Knoll Park is at the corner of Big Bend Blvd. and Clayton Road. Enter the park from Big Bend. The Guild is the second stone mansion on the left.



## EXHIBITION JUROR: Marilynne Bradley

Marilynne Bradley's curiosity of the world around her is reflected in her paintings. St. Louis scenes are special to her. Architectural structures compete with crowds of outdoor activity. She records the energetic feelings of life in the streets and in the cafés. The use of her skill as a draftsman enables her to use architectural design elements as she seeks to translate the charm and character of the city into her paintings.

Marilynne received her BFA from Washington University, an MAT from Webster University, and her MFA from Syracuse University. She is a member of the faculty of Webster University and the University of Missouri-Columbia.

## COMMISSIONS

Sales are encouraged. Artists will receive 100% of sales from work sold during the exhibition.

## PRIZES

Approximately \$1,500 in cash prizes will be awarded.
